

# Uniform Guidelines

## Uniform Pants



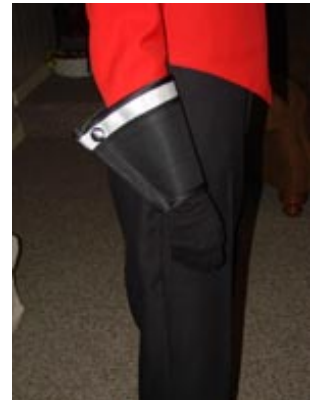
The correct length of the pants should be right at the top of the marching shoe when viewed from the front. There should be no break in the crease. Pants will appear to be too short from the side view. If your hem is still **too long** and you have used the last available snap, please contact the Uniform Mom for proper hemming instructions.



## Jacket Sleeve Length With Gauntlet



The correct length of the sleeves, when instructed to wear the Gauntlets, is right at the wrist. If the sleeve is **too long** it will either hang out at bottom of the Gauntlet or the sleeve will bunch up towards the shoulders. There is a right and left Gauntlet. The silver snap, which is to be facing out, will determine which arm to wear it on as shown in the picture.



## Jacket Sleeve Length Without Gauntlet

The correct length of the sleeves, when the student is not wearing the Gauntlet, is right at the Y of the hand between the thumb and index finger as shown in the picture. The Band Directors will notify the students whether they will be performing with or without the Gauntlets. **The students must be prepared to raise or lower the hem when instructed.**
